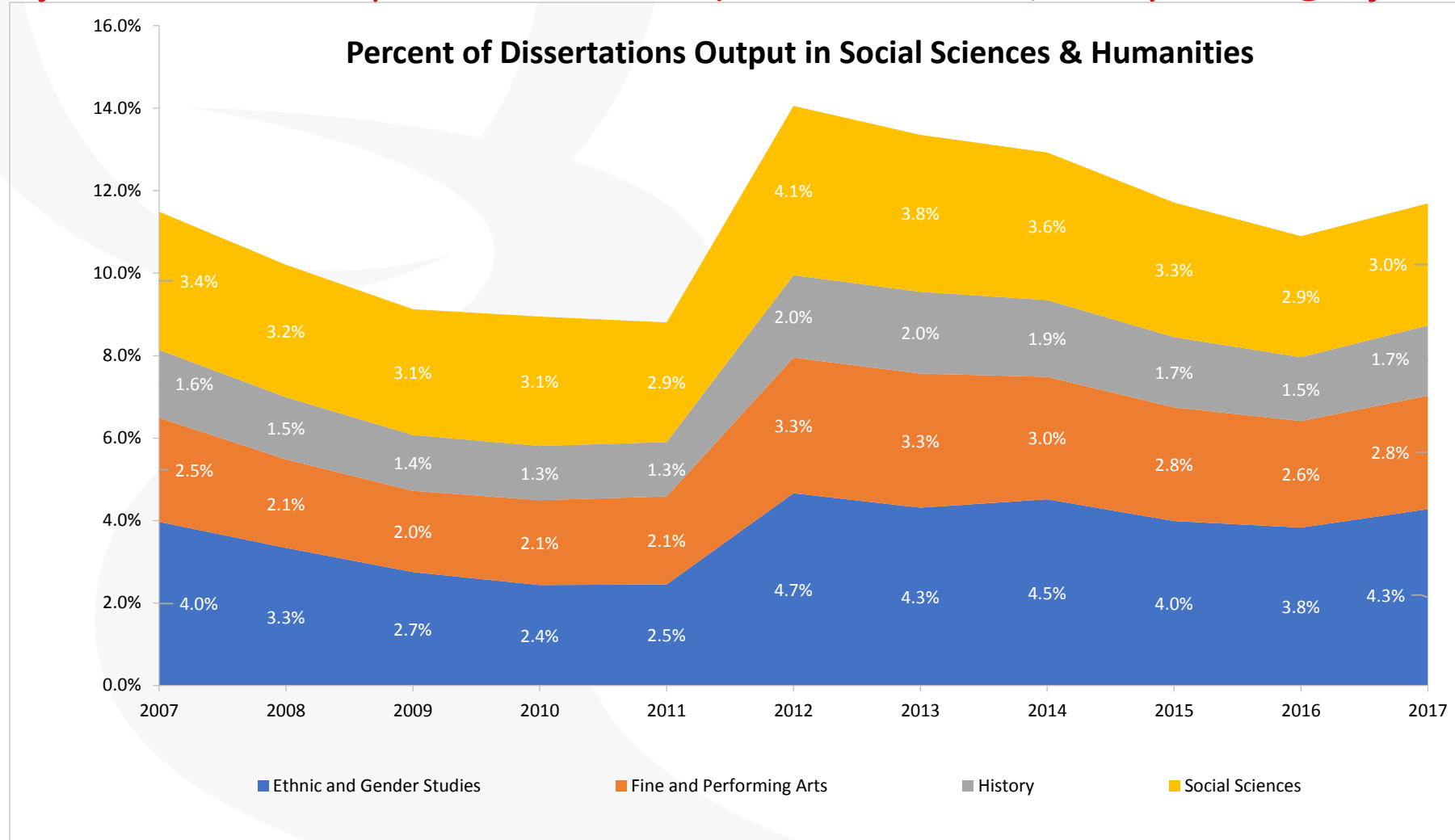

 FROM THE STEPS OF THE CAPITOL  
 January 20, 1957

MY FELLOW-COUNTRYMEN:

When four years ago we met to inaugurate a President, the Republic, single-minded in anxiety, stood in spirit here. We dedicated ourselves to the fulfillment of a vision -- to spend the time when there would be for all the people that security and peace essential to the pursuit of happiness. We of the Republic pledged ourselves to drive from the temple of our ancient faith those who had profaned it; to end by action, tireless and unceasing, the stagnation and despair of that day.

We did those first things first.

Our covenant with ourselves did not stop there. Instinctively we recognized a deeper need -- the need to firm through government the instrument of our united purpose to solve for the individual the ever-rising problems of a complex civilization. Repeated attempts at their solution without the aid of government had left us baffled and bewildered. For, without that aid, we had been unable to create those moral controls over the services of science which are necessary to make science a useful servant instead of a ruthless

The National Commission on Marijuana and Drug Abuse unanimously recommended today a policy of discouragement for marijuana use. While rejecting legislation of the drug ban, as in the case of alcohol, the Commission declared that an effective discouragement policy does not require making private possession of marijuana a crime nor does it recommend putting the users in jail.

In its Report, *Marijuana: A Signal of Misunderstanding*, which was submitted to President Eisenhower at the White House and to the Congress, the Commission recommended that possession for personal use in private and casual non-commercial sales in private not be made criminal offenses.

However, the Commission recommended the retention of heavy penalties for cultivation, trafficking, and possession with intent to sell. Use in public would be a criminal offense and the drug, if found in public,

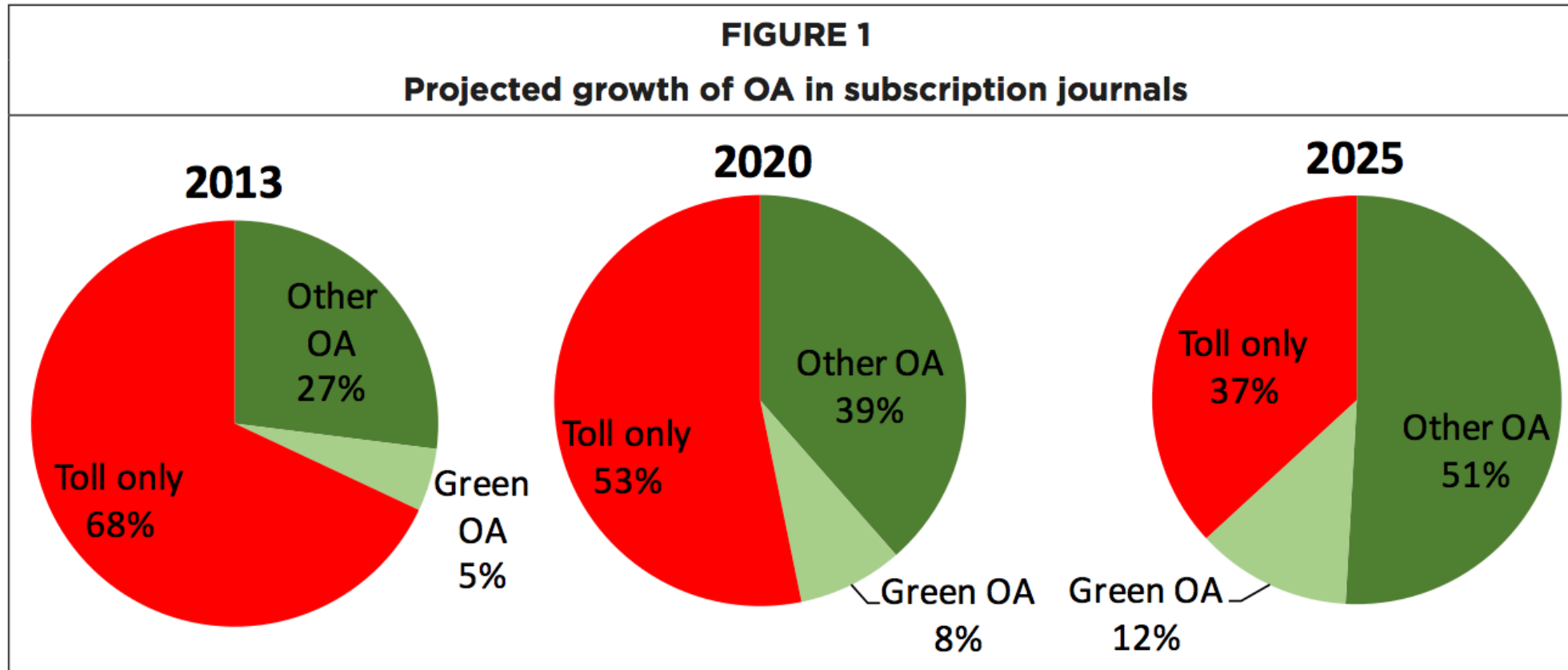
