





文章内容



On September 1, 1939, German armed forces suddenly invaded Poland. Two days later France and Great Britain declared war against Germany, and Europe was swept into a second world war.

World War II was the most widespread and the most destructive **war** in history. It lasted from 1939 to 1945 and eventually involved all the great powers and most of the smaller nations of the **world**. The chief antagonists were Germany, Italy, and Japan—the Axis Powers—on one side and the United States, Great Britain, the Soviet Union, France, and China—the Allied Powers—on the other. The battlefields of the **war** stretched from Europe to North Africa and from the islands of the Pacific Ocean to southeastern Asia.

The cost of the war—in death, suffering, and destruction of property—was enormous. Battle deaths alone amounted to about 15 million. Perhaps twice as many civilians lost their lives. Millions more were made homeless. Many of the cities of Europe and Asia were partly or completely destroyed by aerial bombing, and vast areas of land were devastated.

What caused such a terrible conflict? To understand that, it is necessary to go back to 1918, to the end of **World War** I.





Taiwan, the mountainous island off the coast of <u>China</u>, was for centuries a haven for fishermen, a few foreign seafarers, and rebels. The island was still a relatively undeveloped agricultural area when 2 million Chinese Nationalists arrived in 1949, fleeing their longtime foes, the Communists, who had taken over the mainland.

Today, Taiwan—officially known as the Republic of China—is one of Asia's most advanced industrial centers. Its flourishing economy, based on high technology and exporting, is a major supplier of Asian products to foreign countries. Even in the late 1990s, Taiwan was less affected than many Asian countries by the economic downturn engulfing Japan, South Korea, and several industrializing Southeast Asian nations.

Taiwan's development is more than economic. Recently, its institutions have been undergoing a gradual democratization, lending weight to the axiom that one result of economic freedom is political freedom.

The Land

The Republic of China consists of the island of Taiwan, the islands of Quemoy and Matsu, and the 11 islands of the Pescadores chain, which lie between Taiwan and the mainland. The island of Taiwan lies 100 mi. (160 km.) off the southeast coast of mainland China across the Taiwan Strait. By far the largest of the islands making up the Republic of China, Taiwan is about 240 mi. (386 km.) long and 85 mi. (137 km.) wide.

The thickly forested Chungyang mountain range bisects Taiwan from north to south. East of the range, the mountains fall in sharp peaks and gorges to the ocean. This spectacular coastline inspired Portuguese explorers to name the island Formosa, meaning "beautiful." West of the range, the mountains gradually give way to a broad, fertile, and well-cultivated plain, where most of the people live.













(2) Thematic主題地圖




World, agriculture 主題地圖:農、林、漁、牧、工業、經濟...等項目主題地圖



(3) Exploration探索地圖




探索地圖: 麥哲倫、弗朗西斯·德雷克爵士、詹姆斯·庫克 World explorations
